

LONG-TERM UNEMPLOYMENT AS A PROBLEM OF THE POLISH LABOUR MARKET

Abstract:

The positive change noted on the Polish labour market in 2015 was a decrease of the registered unemployment rate below a level of 10%, that is to 9.7%. Such a change may indicate that the Polish labour market develops in a good direction. Looking at the labour market from the perspective of the long-term unemployment rate indicates that it becomes a problem for the Polish labour market. The objective of this study is to analyse the issue of the long-term unemployment in Poland.
